

Eagle Glacier Equipment Recommendation

Ski equipment: Classic and Skate. We typically use good skis. Conditions are typically klister skiing and spring condition (rills).

Wax Equipment: Scraper, brush, spring condition klister (One tube of violet, red, and Swix Universal) and glide wax. We supply irons and heat guns.

Clothes: Weather can range from summer to winter conditions (20-70 F) with rain, snow, or beautiful sun shine. Bring training and normal clothes appropriate for these conditions.

Personal items: Tooth brush, shampoo, etc.

Towels and linens are provided. No need for sleeping bags.

Special items:

- Hiking boots or sturdy trail shoes for the hike out. The hike is mountain hiking with steep slopes and demanding terrain (3000 ft over 2 miles).
- Rain gear for training
- Water resistant/proof parka for the hike out.
- Sun screen
- Sun glasses
- Day pack for the hike out
- Climbing Harness and one locking carabineer. Other glacier travel equipment optional. Please do not bring an ice axe, unless approved by the director.

Energy bars/drink (optional)

*Weight limit is 30 Lbs for your personal gear bag. We pay by weight, so over-weight will be charged.

*Gear will be flown out via helicopter at the end of the week. There is a potential that gear may be delayed due to weather. Due to the terrain and increased risk to injury, carrying heavy gear bags out is not permitted.
